Professor in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering

The University of New Orleans (UNO) is seeking applicants for a tenure track position at the Assistant/Associate/Full Professor level in its School of Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering. Candidates should have a PhD degree in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering (NAME). While not required, relevant experience in the marine field, including academics, would weigh significantly in the selection.

Background and interest is sought particularly in marine hydrodynamics, but orientation in the supporting disciplines of marine structures, marine dynamics, and marine propulsion is also desired. Strong commitment to excellence in teaching and research is expected.

The College of Engineering at UNO offers undergraduate as well as graduate degrees in NAME and has an active PhD program. The successful candidate should have an interest in recruiting, supervising and working with PhD students. The School of NAME is strongly involved in externally funded research. With the importance of technology transfer in modern research incentives, the candidate must be committed to guiding academic research output to the applied level. Development of a record of funded research and professional technical activity with industry and government is expected.

Salary will be consistent with nationally established levels for academic positions in engineering. US citizenship is not a requirement.
